Culberson, Beulah Pearl Mitchell, 95 of Gainesville passed away January 31, 2014 at the E.T. York Hospice Care Center. Beulah was born in Greenwood, MS on December 18, 1918 and attended school in Lake Village, Arkansas and Winter Haven, Florida. She obtained a B.S. in Education degree from Florida State College for Women in Tallahassee and was a pioneering elementary school teacher in South Bay and Pahokee in the Florida Glades. She was married to Hugo Boe, a Pahokee farmer and city commissioner for 19 years and they had two sons, Dr. Robert Boe of Destin and William "Bill" Boe of Gainesville.
