Charles F. Fox, Captain, USAF, Retired

Charles F. ("Chuck" or "Sonny") Fox passed away February 23, 2015 in Lewisville, Texas. He was 75.

Capt. Fox was born in Carnegie, PA on June 25, 1939 to Charles L. Fox and Irene Penn Fox. He was a member of the class of '57 at Carnegie High School and a graduate of Indiana University (B.S.), the University of Missouri (M.S.) and the University of Florida (J.D.).

Capt. Fox served for 21 years in the United States Air Force in varying capacities, including Commandant of Cadets for the Air Force ROTC at Washburn University in Topeka, KS. Upon retirement, he moved to Gainesville, FL, where he resided for more than 30 years.
