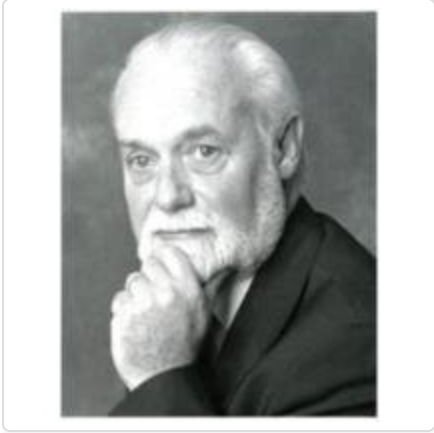




Donald (Don) Armstrong
