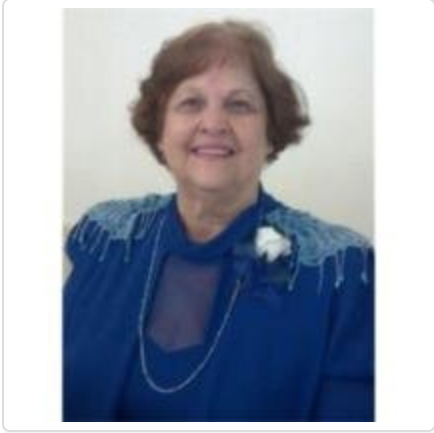




Judith D. Thompson
