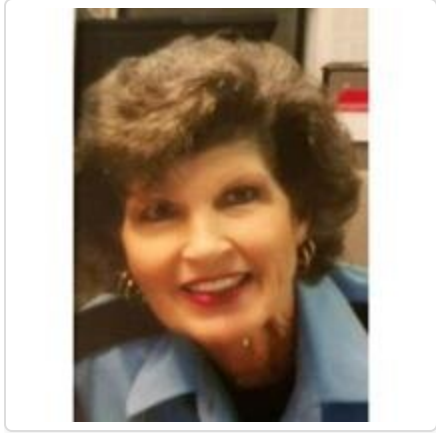




Linda Sapp McMillan
