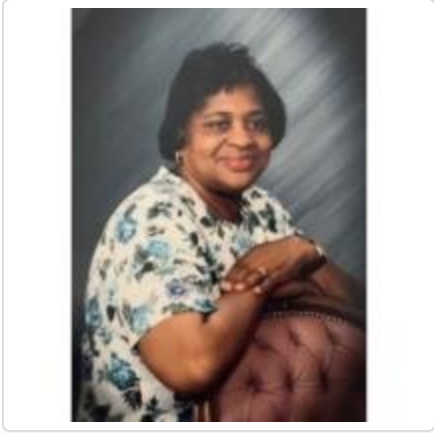




Mercia "GT" Reid (Williams)
