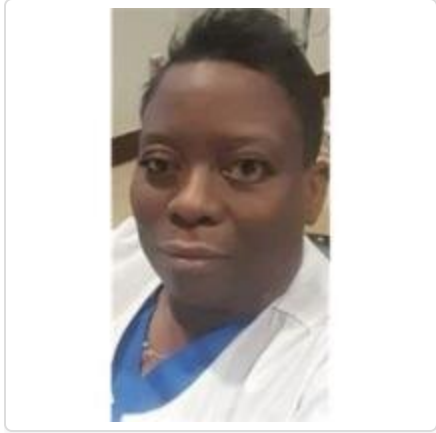




Tina Marchelle Williams
